Music in the Grand Lobby feat. Aaron Doenges

A visit to Aaron Doenges' website reveals that there was an earthquake in Ohio on the day the Buckeye-born composer/sound artist came into the world. Lately, Doenges has been shaking things up here in Music City, drifting between the worlds of art and music with his thoughtful audio-collage compositions. "I never try to define my music too much," he explains. "Sometimes the result surprises me. It almost always makes me think." Doenges curated last autumn's international sound art festival SoundCrawl:Nashville, and this show at the Frist is one of many he has planned for the spring and summer. The Frist's recent musical lineup finds the art venue developing a rep as a place to hear great tunes, and Doenges is a natural for their ongoing Music in the Grand Lobby series.
