Soundcrawl:Nashville

When: Sat., Oct. 2, 2-6 p.m. 2010

Just as visual art takes images from the natural world and supplants them onto a canvas or gallery wall, sound art removes sounds from their original context, and through isolation and/or adaptation, new ideas about the nature of sound and auditory experience emerge. Last year's SoundCrawl:Nashville successfully turned the Art Crawl into a scavenger hunt for sounds, and at this Saturday's Gallery Crawl, it's returning with new sound-art compositions from around the world. The event's directors are local composers Aaron Doenges and Kyle Baker, and they feature ambient, electronic, traditional and non-musical sounds, and have added some digital video art to the mix. Participating venues include Twist Gallery, Sperka Gallery, Ryan Hutchinson in studio No. 61, Be!Art, The Downtown Presbyterian Church and The Rymer Gallery, who will also be hosting the sound works through the end of the month.
